**Minnesota State Lottery**  
**Minnesota Lottery's NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ Second Chance**  
**June 29, 2026**

**1.1. Definitions**

- A. **“Minnesota Lottery's NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ Second Chance”** means an additional opportunity to win through a drawing conducted by the Minnesota Lottery in conjunction with the purchase of a Powerball® Ticket.
- B. **“Prize Provider”** means the Multi-State Lottery Association (MUSL) or a third party under contract with MUSL to fulfill all elements of the Minnesota Lottery's NASCAR Powerball The Chase™.
- C. **“The Lottery”** means the Minnesota State Lottery.
- D. **“NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ Second Chance Promotion”** or **“Second Chance”** means a nationwide additional opportunity to win that is a component of the Minnesota Lottery's NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ and governed by the Trip Prize Terms and Conditions and Trip Prize Description documents that are attached to these Official Drawing Rules and incorporated by reference. In the event of a conflict between these Official Rules and the incorporated documents, these Official Rules shall govern.
- E. **“Account”** means a player has registered at [mnlottery.com](https://mnlottery.com) or on the Minnesota Lottery mobile app with all required personal contact information.

**2.1. Duration**

The Minnesota Lottery's NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ Second Chance will begin at 5:00:00 a.m. Central Time (“CT”) on June 29, 2026, and conclude at 11:59:59 p.m. CT on July 29, 2026. Entries must be received by 11:59:59 p.m. CT on August 2, 2026.

**3.1. Eligibility**

- A. A player who submits an entry must be eighteen (18) years of age or older.
- B. A player may enter the Minnesota Lottery's NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ Second Chance by creating or having an Account at [mnlottery.com](https://mnlottery.com), logging in to their account, supplying all required registration information completely and in its entirety, and entering the 24-digit 2nd Chance code found under the “SCAN THIS BARCODE TO CHECK TICKETS ON THE LOTTERY APP” on the front of eligible Powerball® tickets on the Minnesota Lottery mobile app or by scanning that same barcode found on Powerball® tickets. Entries must be received by August 2, 2026. Only tickets purchased from 5:00:00 a.m. on June 29, 2026 through July

29, 2026 at 11:59:59 p.m. Central Time (“CT”) qualify for this NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ Promotion. Incomplete registration information may result in entry disqualification.

- C. Each dollar spent on eligible Powerball® tickets will receive one (1) entry in the Minnesota Lottery’s NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ Second Chance. (For example: One (1) Powerball play [\$2] = two (2) entries. One (1) Powerball play [\$2] + One (1) Powerplay [\$1] = three (3) entries.)
- D. Only one (1) winner per household per drawing is permitted. Each entry must correspond to one (1) person.
- E. Employees (including immediate family residing in the same household) of the Lottery, employees (including immediate family residing in the same household) of any company that is not eligible to receive a prize from the Lottery pursuant to law or a contract with the Lottery, and all other persons prohibited by law are ineligible to participate or receive a prize from the Minnesota Lottery’s NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ Second Chance.
- F. The Lottery, MUSL, Homestead-Miami Speedway, LLC and National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing, LLC (“NASCAR”) is not responsible for delayed, lost, or misdirected electronic submissions made through the Internet.
- G. A player who submits an entry is responsible for providing their correct contact information and U.S. Postal Service mailing address. Failure to report a prize not received within one (1) year will result in forfeiture of any prize won.
- H. A player may enter more than once; however, a player may use only one (1) unique Powerball Ticket number or barcode per entry. Multiple entries using the same Powerball Ticket number or barcode and entries made via automated computer scripts or other programming techniques will be disqualified.
- I. A player who uses a Powerball Ticket as an entry in this Minnesota Lottery’s NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ Second Chance that has previously been used in any other Minnesota Lottery Second Chance, sweepstakes, or contest will be considered ineligible.
- J. If a player has deleted their account, any entries submitted before the account was deleted will not be eligible for any prize. Any Tickets a player purchased before deleting their account are not eligible for re-entry.
- K. By participating, players agree to these official rules and to the decisions of the Lottery and the Prize Provider which will be final and binding in all respects.

- L. An entry will be considered invalid if it does not meet all requirements for eligibility stated in this section.

**4.1. Minnesota Lottery’s NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ Second Chance Drawings**

- A. To enter the Minnesota Lottery’s NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ Second Chance, a player must enter the 24-digit code found on an eligible Powerball Ticket via the process described above. The Lottery will conduct one (1) Minnesota Lottery’s NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ Second Chance drawing. The eligibility and schedule for each drawing are listed in the table below.

- B. The Lottery will, by use of mechanical or other devices, randomly determine which of the entries submitted are selected.
- C. The Lottery will conduct one (1) drawing. A Lottery representative will draw twenty-six (26) total winners for the following prizes:
  - One (1) prize of \$2,000 cash and a prize pack with an estimated taxable value of \$2,020, and one (1) entry for the NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ prize (Lottery-branded merchandise is valued at \$0).
    - Shortly after October 22, 2026, the Prize Provider will conduct one (1) drawing from all eligible entries for the Trip Prize pursuant to the Trip Prize Terms and Conditions attached to these official rules.
  - Twenty-five (25) prizes of \$250 cash and a prize pack with an estimated taxable value of \$270 (Lottery-branded merchandise is valued at \$0).

The Lottery reserves the right to substitute prizes for any reason, including availability. The Lottery offers no express or implied warranty or guarantee of merchandise prizes. Entrants are responsible for checking their email spam folders or adjusting their email settings to accommodate emails from the Lottery.

D. The Lottery, MUSL, NASCAR®, Homestead-Miami Speedway, LLC and/or any of their affiliated entities are not responsible, in any way, for any personal injuries, death, property damage, or other damages or expenses resulting from or arising out of any acceptance, fulfillment (including shipping and handling), installation, operation, loss, or misuse of the prize and/or any element thereof. All other costs and expenses related to acceptance and use of any element of the prize not specified herein as being provided may be the sole responsibility of prizewinner, including, without limitation, any fees, costs, and/or taxes related to the Minnesota Lottery's NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ promotion.

E. The first entry drawn in Drawing #1 will receive \$2,000 cash, one (1) Lottery-branded T-shirt, one (1) pair of Lottery-branded sunglasses, one (1) Lottery-branded cooling towel, one (1) Lottery-branded sling bag, one (1) Lottery-branded tumbler, one (1) Lottery-branded can cooler, and one (1) NASCAR®-branded keychain and one (1) entry for the NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ Trip Prize.

The next twenty-five (25) entries drawn in Drawing #1 will each receive \$250 cash, one (1) Lottery-branded T-shirt, one (1) pair of Lottery-branded sunglasses, one (1) Lottery-branded cooling towel, one (1) Lottery-branded sling bag, one (1) Lottery-branded tumbler, one (1) Lottery-branded can cooler, and one (1) NASCAR®-branded keychain.

F. A player may win only once in each Minnesota Lottery's NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ Second Chance drawing, but may win a prize in more than one (1) drawing.

G. By entering this Second Chance, players understand that if they win a prize their name will be listed on the [Second Chance winners page](#) unless their prize includes a cash payment greater than \$10,000. A list of all prizewinners will be posted on the [mnlottery.com winners page](#) following the drawing and after prizewinners have been verified. The list will remain on the winners page for the duration of the Claim Period (as defined below).

H. By entering the Minnesota Lottery's NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ Second Chance, prizewinners of prizes valued at \$599 or less consent to full use of any and all information they provide on their entry form for publicity, public

relations, and content creation purposes, including on Lottery social media channels and [mnlottery.com](http://mnlottery.com), by the Lottery.

- I. The name and city of prizewinners of prizes that include a cash payment of \$10,000 or less are public data. The Lottery will publish the name and city of prizewinners of prizes that include a cash payment of \$10,000 or less on [mnlottery.com](http://mnlottery.com).

#### 5.1. **Claiming Prizes**

- A. A prize won in a Second Chance may not be assigned or transferred to another person. A Second Chance prize containing merchandise, scratch tickets, or experiences may not be claimed with another person under a prize-sharing agreement. A cash prize of \$600 or more may be claimed with another person under a pre-existing prize-sharing agreement. Federal, state, or local taxes on any prize are the sole responsibility of the claimant. All applicable federal, state, or local laws apply.
- B. Prizes with a value of \$599 or less will be shipped to the address listed in the prizewinner's Account after the drawing in which they are awarded. The Lottery is not responsible for lost or misdirected delivery. Prizes returned to the Lottery may be claimed by the prizewinner during the Claim Period (as defined below).
- C. The prizewinner is responsible for providing their correct contact information and U.S. Postal Service mailing address.
- D. Each player whose entry was selected in a Second Chance drawing to win a prize valued at \$600 or more must fill out and submit a Winner Affidavit form to the Lottery to claim the prize. If the claim is not validated by the Lottery, the claim will be denied, and the player will be notified immediately.
  - 1. For the \$2,000 cash + prize pack, if the prizewinner is delinquent in the payment of Minnesota state taxes or owes a debt as defined in [Minn. Stat. § 270A.03, subd. 5](#), any Lottery-branded merchandise will be forfeited, the amount due will be deducted from the value of the prize, and the Lottery will satisfy or partially satisfy the debt on the prizewinner's behalf. If any cash (or cash equivalents) remains after the Lottery has forwarded the proceeds of a cash prize to the [Minnesota Department of Revenue](#), the prizewinner will be awarded the remaining cash.

### 6.1. Claim Period

All prizes in the Minnesota Lottery's NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ Second Chance must be claimed within one (1) year of the date of the drawing from which the prize was awarded. For prizes of \$600 or more or inquiries regarding lost, stolen, or misdirected prizes, the claim period ends at the close of business on the last day of the claim period that Lottery offices are open. Lottery offices are closed for the holidays and events listed on [mnlottery.com](http://mnlottery.com), and one (1) or more Lottery offices may close unexpectedly due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances. The Lottery reserves the right to substitute prizes based on when the prize is claimed during the claim period. The Lottery will post the end of the claim period on [mnlottery.com](http://mnlottery.com). Questions may be referred to the Lottery at (651) 635-8273, option 1, or [cs.support@mnlottery.com](mailto:cs.support@mnlottery.com). Prizewinners must contact the Lottery within one (1) year of the drawing date regarding a lost, stolen, or misdirected prize. Failure to report a prize not received within one (1) year will result in forfeiture of any prize won.

Winners of the Minnesota Lottery's NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ Second Chance prize must submit their claim and satisfy any debts pursuant to 5.1, D.1, above, by October 22, 2026 to receive a Trip Prize rather than a substitute prize.

### 7.1. Allowance for Delay of Payment

The Lottery may delay payment pending a final determination by the Lottery under any of the following circumstances.

- A. if a dispute occurs or it appears likely that a dispute may occur regarding the prize;
- B. if a dispute occurs or it appears likely that a dispute may occur regarding the ownership of the entry;
- C. if there is any question regarding the identity of the claimant;
- D. if there is any question regarding the validity of the entry or the claim presented for payment; or
- E. if the claim is subject to any reduction for delinquent debts owed by the claimant under [Minn. Stat. § 349A.08, subd. 8](#). No liability for interest for any delay will accrue to the benefit of the claimant pending payment of the claim.

### 8.1. Emergency Termination

If, for any reason, it is not possible to run all or any part of the Minnesota Lottery's NASCAR Powerball The Chase™ Second Chance as planned due to, without limitation, errors in these official rules or advertising for this promotion, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, human error, or any other cause beyond the

control of the Lottery that, in the sole judgment of the Lottery, could corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of this Second Chance, the Lottery reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify, or suspend the promotion.

**9.1. Governing Law**

By submitting an entry to a Second Chance, a player agrees to comply with and abide by these game procedures: [Minn. Stat. § 349A](#) (State Lottery); [Minn. R. 7857](#) (Lottery Prize Payments); and all final decisions of the Director of the Lottery. All applicable federal, state, or local laws apply. Second Chance offer void where prohibited by law.

NOTE: TERMS USED BUT NOT SPECIFICALLY DEFINED IN THESE TRIP PRIZE TERMS AND CONDITIONS [E.G., "FINALIST", "TRIP PRIZE", ETC.] MAY BE CHANGED TO BE CONSISTENT WITH THE PARTICIPATING LOTTERIES' CUSTOMARY LANGUAGE USED IN ITS RULES/DISCLOSURES FOR THIS PROMOTION.

THE TERM "PARTICIPATING LOTTERY" OR "PARTICIPATING LOTTERIES" MEANS THOSE LOTTERIES THAT HAVE OFFERED THE NASCAR-POWERBALL THE CHASE PROMOTION.

THE TERM "PRIZE PROVIDER" IS THE MULTI-STATE LOTTERY ASSOCIATION (MUSL), OR, A THIRD-PARTY UNDER CONTRACT WITH MUSL TO FULFILL ALL ELEMENTS OF THE TRIP PRIZE EXCEPT THE SECOND PLACE CASH PRIZE OF \$10,000, AND THE \$1 MILLION PRIZE.

If Finalist resides fewer than two hundred fifty (250) miles from Miami, FL, Prize Provider, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to provide ground transportation for Finalist and Guest in lieu of airline transportation. If Finalist is under the age of twenty-one (21), Guest must be at least the age of majority in Guest's state of residence. Finalist must execute and return all required documentation to Participating Lottery within five (5) days of Finalist's receipt (or such shorter period as production exigencies may require). If Finalist elects to appoint a proxy, they must appoint the proxy and provide contact information for the proxy on or before Thursday, October 22, 2026.

- If Finalist chooses a proxy, the proxy must satisfy the Production Requirements to participate in the Trip Prize and/or participate in the broadcast of the Program. In the event that Finalist's designated proxy does not satisfy the Production Requirements, Prize Provider reserves the right, in its sole discretion, either to (i) allow Finalist to appoint another proxy to participate in the Trip Prize and/or to appear in the Program in Finalist's place (subject to Prize Provider's production schedule and deadlines and satisfying the Production Requirements); or (ii) a proxy will be selected by Prize Provider to appear in the Program in Finalist's (or proxy's) place.
- If Finalist appoints a proxy (or has a proxy appointed), Finalist will remain eligible to win the \$1 Million Prize. Finalist may only transfer the Trip Prize (excluding eligibility for the \$1 Million Grand Prize drawing) in its entirety one (1) time to a proxy.

By accepting any ticketed portion of the Trip Prize, Finalist agrees to abide by any terms, conditions, and restrictions provided by the ticket. Lost, mutilated, or stolen tickets, vouchers, certificates, or pre-paid gift cards will not be replaced.

No prize element substitution, cash substitution, assignment, or transfer of the Trip Prize or any elements thereof is permitted. Any unused elements of the Trip Prize will be forfeited, will not be redeemable for cash, and may not reduce the prize value awarded for tax purposes. Notwithstanding the foregoing:

- If Finalist misses their flight for any reason, reasonable efforts will be used to reschedule the flight at Finalist's expense. If the flight is not able to be rescheduled in a reasonable time for Finalist's participation in the Events, (i) Finalist shall forfeit and not participate in the travel portion of the Trip Prize, including attendance at and participation in the Events; (ii) Finalist will still receive the two (2) Souvenir Gift Bags (less any tax withholdings and any outstanding debt setoff, if applicable); and (iii) Finalist will remain eligible for the \$1 Million Prize drawing.
- If Finalist is unable to travel in connection with the Trip Prize for any reason after tickets have been booked/purchased, (i) Finalist shall forfeit and not participate in the travel portion of the Trip Prize,

including attendance at and participation in the Events; (ii) Finalist will still receive the two (2) Souvenir Gift Bags (less any tax withholdings and any outstanding debt setoff, if applicable); and (iii) Finalist will remain eligible for the \$1 Million Grand Prize drawing

- If Finalist fails to attend the Event at which the \$1 Million Grand Prize drawing occurs, Finalist will remain eligible for the \$1 Million Grand Prize drawing.
