

**Official Drawing Rules
Minnesota State Lottery
Powerball Xs & Os™ Promotions Program
Adopted September 8, 2026**

1.1. Definitions

- A. “Powerball Xs & Os™” or “Ticket” or “Game” means the Minnesota Lottery lotto game, Powerball Xs & Os™.
- B. **“Powerball Xs & Os™ Promotions Program”** means an additional opportunity to win through a drawing conducted by the Multi-State Lottery Association (“MUSL”) in conjunction with the purchase of a Powerball Xs & Os™ Ticket. In addition to these Official Drawing Rules, these additional opportunities to win are governed by the Rules for the Powerball Xs and Os™ National Promotions Program Offered on the Official Powerball® App, PowerballOfficial.com, and the MUSL Powerball Xs & Os™ Product Group Rules. In the case of a conflict, the Rules for the Powerball Xs and Os™ National Promotions Program Offered on the Official Powerball® App and the MUSL Powerball Xs & Os™ Product Group Rules shall govern.
- C. **“The Lottery”** means the Minnesota State Lottery.
- D. **“Powerball Xs & Os™ Promotion”** or **“Promotion”** means the drawings conducted by MUSL in conjunction with the Powerball Xs & Os™ Promotions Program.
- E. **“Account”** means a Player has registered and provided all required personal contact information on PowerballOfficial.com or on the Powerball Official App, each of which is operated and managed by MUSL. Accounts on the Lottery’s website or mobile apps are not included as an Account for purposes of the Promotion.
- F. **“Powerball Official App”** or **“Powerball Official Mobile App”** means the mobile app that is owned and managed by MUSL, hosted by a third-party, and available for download on the Powerball Official Website, Apple App Store, and Google Play.
- G. **“Powerball Official Website”** means the website found at <https://www.PowerballOfficial.com> (and linked at <https://www.powerball.com>) that is owned and managed by MUSL and hosted by a third-party.

2.1. Duration

The Powerball Xs & Os™ Promotion will begin on September 8, 2026, and conclude on a date to be determined (“TBD”) by the Lottery or MUSL. The drawing schedule and prizing will be available on the Powerball Official App or website.

3.1. Eligibility

- A. A player who submits an entry must be eighteen (18) years of age or older.
- B. A player may enter the Powerball Xs & Os™ Promotion by creating or having an Account, logging in to their account, supplying all required registration information completely and in its entirety, and entering the required information found on a Ticket on PowerballOfficial.com or on the Powerball Official App. Incomplete registration information may result in entry disqualification.
- C. For every dollar (\$1.00) spent on the Game, one Point will be awarded; each Point awarded can be used as an Entry into a Promotion. Promotional windows may be made available where Eligible Tickets can be multiplied for additional available Entries. An eligible Powerball Xs & Os™ Ticket must be entered no more than ninety (90) days from the last drawing date printed on the Ticket.
- D. Employees (including immediate family residing in the same household) of the Lottery, employees (including immediate family residing in the same household) of any company that is not eligible to receive a prize from the Lottery pursuant to law or a contract with the Lottery, and all other persons prohibited by law are ineligible to participate or receive a prize from the Powerball Xs & Os™ Promotion.
- E. By participating, players agree to these Official Drawing Rules, the Rules for the Powerball Xs and Os™ National Promotions Program Offered on the Official Powerball® App, the MUSL Powerball Xs & Os™ Product Group Rules, and to the decisions of the Lottery and MUSL which will be final and binding in all respects.
- F. An entry will be considered invalid if it does not meet all requirements for eligibility stated in this section.
- G. MUSL and the Minnesota Lottery are not responsible for the following events: delayed, lost, or misdirected electronic, mailed, or any other types of submissions as may be allowed by the Minnesota Lottery; connectivity issues involved in the Player’s access to the Powerball Official Website or Powerball Official App; or data entry errors by players.
- H. A player who submits an Entry is responsible for providing their correct contact information and U.S. Postal Service mailing address.

- I. If a Player has deleted their Account, any Points earned or Entries submitted before the Account was deleted will not be eligible for any promotional prize. Any Eligible Tickets a Player has entered before deleting their Account are not allowed for re-entry should a Player establish a subsequent Account.

4.1. Powerball Xs & Os™ Second Promotional Drawings

- A. To enter the Powerball Xs & Os™ Promotion, a player must enter a Ticket via the process described in Section 3.1(B). MUSL will conduct drawings as described on PowerballOfficial.com or on the Powerball Official App.
- B. MUSL will, by use of mechanical or other devices, randomly determine which of the entries submitted are selected.
- C. MUSL and the Lottery reserve the right to substitute prizes for any reason, including availability. MUSL and the Lottery offer no express or implied warranty or guarantee of merchandise prizes. Entrants are responsible for checking their email spam folders or adjusting their email settings to accommodate emails from the Lottery.
- D. MUSL, the Lottery, the NFL and/or any of their affiliated entities are not responsible, in any way, for any personal injuries, death, property damage, or other damages or expenses resulting from or arising out of any acceptance, fulfillment (including shipping and handling), installation, operation, loss, or misuse of the prize and/or any element thereof. All other costs and expenses related to acceptance and use of any element of the prize not specified as being provided may be the sole responsibility of prizewinner, including, without limitation, any fees, costs, and/or taxes related to transportation.
- E. By entering this Promotion, players understand that if they win a prize their name may be listed on the Second Chance winners page unless their prize includes a cash payment greater than \$10,000. A list of all prizewinners may be posted on the mnlottery.com winners page following the drawing and after prizewinners have been verified. The list may remain on the winners page for the duration of the Claim Period (as defined below).
- F. By entering the Powerball Xs & Os™ National Promotions Program, prizewinners of prizes valued at \$599 or less consent to full use of any and all information they provide on their entry form for publicity, public relations, and content creation purposes, including on Lottery social media channels and mnlottery.com, by the Lottery.
- G. The name and city of prizewinners of prizes that include a cash payment of \$10,000 or less are public data. The Lottery will publish the name and city of

prizewinners of prizes that include a cash payment of \$10,000 or less on mnlottery.com.

- H. For questions pertaining to a player's account, identity verification, Ticket history, points, entries, app behavior, or technical investigation, visit the Help/Support section of the Powerball app or website.

5.1. Claiming Prizes

- A. All prizes in the Promotion must be claimed directly pursuant to the Rules for the Powerball Xs and Os™ National Promotions Program Offered on the Official Powerball® App and the MUSL Powerball Xs & Os™ Product Group Rules.
- B. Prizes with a value of \$499 or less may be claimed automatically and shipped to the address listed in the prizewinner's Account after the drawing in which they are awarded. MUSL and the Lottery are not responsible for lost or misdirected delivery. The prizewinner is responsible for providing their correct contact information and U.S. Postal Service mailing address.
- C. Each player whose entry was selected in a drawing to win a prize valued at \$499 will be contacted by the Lottery or MUSL and must fill out and submit a Winner Affidavit form to the Lottery to claim the prize. If the claim is not validated by the Lottery, the claim will be denied, and the player will be notified immediately. The prizewinner is responsible for providing their correct contact information.
- D. For prizes valued at \$499 or more, if the prizewinner is delinquent in the payment of Minnesota state taxes or owes a debt as defined in Minn. Stat. § 270A.03, subd. 5, the prizewinner may be given an opportunity to fully satisfy the debt, as determined by the Minnesota Department of Revenue, and receive the prize. If the prizewinner fails to completely satisfy the debt within the time period specified for the drawing in which they won the prize, the Lottery will liquidate the prize and forward any proceeds to the Department of Revenue to satisfy or partially satisfy the debt on the prizewinner's behalf. If any cash remains, the prizewinner will be awarded the remaining cash. The prizewinner will have no further rights to the prize.

6.1. Minnesota Claim Period

All prizes in the Promotion must be claimed within one (1) year of the date of the drawing from which the prize was awarded. Prizes with a value of \$499 or less may be claimed automatically and shipped to the address listed in the prizewinner's Account after the drawing in which they are awarded. Winners of prizes valued at \$599 or above must submit their claim and satisfy any debts pursuant to Section 5.1(E), above, within the time period specified for the drawing in which they won the prize to receive the

prize rather than a substitute prize. The Lottery reserves the right to substitute prizes based on when the prize is claimed during the Minnesota Claim Period. Questions may be referred to the Lottery at (651) 635-8273, option 1, or cs.support@mnlottery.com.

7.1. Allowance for Delay of Payment

The Lottery may delay payment pending a final determination by the Lottery under any of the following circumstances.

- A. if a dispute occurs or it appears likely that a dispute may occur regarding the prize;
- B. if a dispute occurs or it appears likely that a dispute may occur regarding the ownership of the entry;
- C. if there is any question regarding the identity of the claimant;
- D. if there is any question regarding the validity of the entry or the claim presented for payment; or
- E. if the claim is subject to any reduction for delinquent debts owed by the claimant under Minn. Stat. § 349A.08, subd. 8. No liability for interest for any delay will accrue to the benefit of the claimant pending payment of the claim.

8.1. Emergency Termination

If, for any reason, it is not possible to run all or any part of the Powerball Xs & Os™ Promotions as planned due to, without limitation, errors in these Official Drawing Rules, the Rules for the Powerball Xs and Os™ National Promotions Program Offered on the Official Powerball® App, and the MUSL Powerball Xs & Os™ Product Group Rules or advertising for this promotion, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, human error, or any other cause beyond the control of MUSL or the Lottery that, in the sole judgment of MUSL or the Lottery, could corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of this Promotion, the MUSL and the Lottery reserve the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify, or suspend the promotion.

9.1. Governing Law

By submitting an entry, a player agrees to comply with and abide by these Official Drawing Rules, the Rules for the Powerball Xs and Os™ National Promotions Program Offered on the Official Powerball® App, the MUSL Powerball Xs & Os™ Product Group Rules, and all final decisions of the Director of the Lottery. All applicable federal, state, or local laws apply. This Promotion is void where prohibited by law.
