POWERBALL TO ADD MONDAY DRAWINGS

Mondays will soon be much more loveable because starting on Aug. 23, 2021, every Monday will be a Powerball drawing day.

The change will give players more of what they want: bigger jackpots more often.

Sales for the first Monday drawing begin on Sunday, Aug. 22, 2021.

The first Monday Powerball drawing will be on Aug. 23, 2021.

It only takes one ticket to win. You can have fun and have a chance to win without spending a lot.

The Minnesota Lottery offers a variety of lotto games to suit our players. Players looking for a twice-a-week jackpot game can try Lotto America®. Tickets are \$1 per play and jackpots start at \$2 million.

Why is Powerball adding a drawing on Monday nights?

We want to pick up the pace of the Powerball game to deliver bigger, faster-growing jackpots to our players.

While the grand prize is always a life-changing amount, players have let us know their excitement of playing the game is focused on larger jackpots.

To meet our players' expectations, Powerball is increasing the number of drawings from two to three nights a week. The additional ticket sales from a third weekly drawing are expected to:

- Produce bigger jackpots.
- Generate faster-growing jackpots each week.
- Increase the number of cash prizes and jackpots awarded each year.
- Increase funding for important projects and programs that benefit Minnesotans.

Will the additional drawing change the Powerball game or prize structure?

No. Players will continue to choose five numbers from 1 to 69 and one Powerball number from 1 to 26.

The set cash prizes will remain the same. The Powerball jackpot will continue to grow based on ticket sales and interest rates between drawings that don't have a jackpot winner.

We anticipate there will be more cash prizes and jackpots awarded each year due to a higher frequency of play.

Does the additional weekly drawing change my odds of winning?

No. Players will still have the same odds of winning a prize because the two pools of numbers from which the winning numbers are drawn will remain the same (5/69 + 1/26).

THINGS TO KNOW

- Drawings will be held Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays starting Monday, Aug. 23, 2021.
- Due to the game change, the number of advance draw purchases will be limited starting on Wednesday, July 7, 2021.
- The first Monday drawing will be on Aug. 23.
- Saturday, Aug. 21 will be the last draw under the Wednesday – Saturday format.
- Powerball will be drawn on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays at approximately 9:59 p.m. CT.
- Tickets must be purchased by 9 p.m. on drawing days.
- Drawings are conducted in the Florida Lottery draw studio in Tallahassee, Florida.
- Recorded videos of the drawings can be viewed at Powerball.com.
- All 48 U.S. Powerball lotteries will offer tickets for Monday drawings.
- Minnesota has had 22 Powerball jackpot winners.
- There are nine ways to win, starting with \$4 for matching just the Powerball. Match the first five numbers plus the Powerball to win the jackpot.
- For an additional \$1 per play, the Power Play® feature can multiply non-jackpot prizes by 2, 3, 4, 5 or 10 times! The multiplier number is randomly selected before each drawing. The 10X multiplier is only in play when the advertised jackpot annuity is \$150 million or less. The Match 5 prize with Power Play is always \$2 million.
- **Multi-draw Tickets:** You can purchase a ticket with up to 14 draws at your favorite retailer. If you choose to play more than one draw, your ticket will include a drawing date range instead of a single draw date.
- Minnesota is not participating in the Double Play add-on at this point.
