#### **MAKING THE SEASON BRIGHT!**

Holiday shopping is in full swing – make sure all your holiday point of purchase materials are still in place. These will help encourage your players to pick up scratch games as a gift for others and maybe even one or two for themselves! #### **REMINDERS**

As we close out 2025, here are a few reminders to wrap up the year and finish with strong sales:

- Scratch games are great gifts. They are easy to wrap, fun to give, and exciting to receive.
- Remind your players that they deserve a treat too! If they are purchasing scratch games as a gift, suggest that they purchase a few extra to keep for themselves.
- Remember that lottery tickets are not appropriate for minors. Encourage your players to give responsibly this holiday season and do your part by checking ID's to make sure anyone purchasing or redeeming lottery tickets is 18 or older.
- Raffle sales end on December 31, 2025, but every year these tickets sell out early. Once all Raffle tickets have been sold, remove any Raffle point-of-purchase materials that are currently on display.
